Young people from our area and beyond are invited to participation in the 9-session animation workshop. The workshop will be run by professional film-maker **James Greatrex**. There will be two assistants, who will be watching over the participants.

You will learn the basics of various kinds of animation and you will learn how to make your own stop-motion movie: from writing the story and creating characters, through building the sets, lighting, filming, sound recording and editing, to final editing – you'll become real film-makers. The movie, created by you during the workshop, will be screened in the Out In The Sticks Cultural Centre and if you make it really good, we will show it at various festivals etc. That's your chance to get famous at an early age!

Terms and Conditions:
(please read carefully and sign)

1. The Out In The Sticks Cultural Association Inc. and James Greatrex, the Workshop Instructor, are the Organizers of the Exploring Motion Image Animation Workshop (the Workshop). The person who signed up to take part in the Workshop is called the Participant.

2. The Participants will be supervised by the Workshop Instructor and at least one more adult person at all times during the time of the Workshop. All reasonable precautions will be undertaken to provide safety and security to the Participants. On their way to and from the Workshop the Participants should be supervised by parents/guardians or other designated persons.
3. The Organizers will provide a good quality Workshop according to the description. If for any reason the Workshop is cancelled they will return all the donations received in connection with the Workshop. In case if only part of the Workshop (like one or two scheduled sessions) is cancelled or moved to the date inconvenient for the Participant, the matter of donation repayments will be negotiated individually.
4. The Participants should attend all of the scheduled Workshop sessions and they should arrive on time. If the Participant's parents/guardians are aware that he/she would have to miss one of the sessions or to come late, they should inform the Organizers about it as early as possible.
5. The Participants will obey all the instructions given by the Workshop Instructor and his Assistants. The Organizers cannot be held responsible for any damages or accidents that might arise from not following these instructions or from any other irresponsible or vicious behaviour of the Participant.
6. If the Participant behaves in a disrespectful manner towards the Workshop Instructor and/or his Assistants and/or the other Participants, or if he/she causes any danger or damage, this Participant may be removed from further participation in the Workshop. In this case any donation paid to the Organizers at registration or later, shall not be returned.
7. Any allergies, health problems or emotional disorders or other problems of the Participant, which might cause any danger to himself/herself or anyone else, should be reported to the Organizers in writing before the first session of the Workshop. The Organizers cannot be held responsible for any accidents or damages that might arise from their unawareness of the aforementioned problems.
8. The Organizers may refuse accepting the Participant to the Workshop if they estimate that problems described in point 7 might prevent the Participant from fully enjoying the Workshop or might cause any danger to other Participants.
9. If the Participant decides (with his/her parents'/guardians' permission) to resign of further participation in the Workshop, the Organizers should be immediately informed in writing. Any donations paid on Registration or later shall not be returned.
10. The copyrights for the stop-motion film produced during the Workshop and for any of its parts, are hereby being transferred to the Out In The Sticks Cultural Association Inc. . The work will be used solely for the creative and promotional purposes (like applying for future grants, participation in film festivals etc.). The Participant's name will be listed in the Credits, unless otherwise requested in writing.
